

About Your Dental Insurance

Please read carefully

Thank you for choosing Lyons Dental for your dental care. We are glad you are here.

You are asked to provide us with your dental insurance information. Please be sure that what you provide is for dental coverage and not medical coverage.

What we expect from you with respect to your dental insurance:

- Provide us with current and accurate information
- Ensure that you are presenting us with information about dental coverage and not medical insurance
- Understand that your dental insurance is an agreement between you and the insurance company or your employer
- Know your annual maximum coverage
- Understand what your insurance allows and will not cover
- Pay your appropriate balance as invoiced

What you can expect from us with respect to your dental insurance:

- We will invoice your dental insurance directly on your behalf and help you use this benefit
- Payment received will be applied to your account
- You will be invoiced for the balance, as allowed by your insurance company

Lyons Dental cannot make guarantees, commitments or promises to you regarding your level of benefits. We suggest that you talk directly with your dental insurance company or your employer.

Dental insurance is different from medical insurance. In most cases it helps you with a portion of your bill and seldom covers all charges. Dental insurance often requires dentists to discount their services and does not allow the dentist to charge you the difference.

Please read the information provided to you by your insurance carrier or employer, and be sure you know which type of insurance you have.

There is no dental insurance company that can prohibit you from seeing the dentist of your choice; however, your insurance may not cover the services
